Oceana is the world's largest international organization dedicated solely to ocean conservation. Since 2001, Oceana and our allies have won more than 275 victories and protected nearly 4 million square miles of ocean. We work in the United States, Canada, the European Union, the United Kingdom, Chile, Mexico, Peru, Brazil, Belize, and the Philippines. Oceana is:

**CAMPAIGN-DRIVEN:** We strategically create campaigns that make measurable progress toward our mission of protecting and restoring the oceans to former levels of abundance. Our campaigns are specific, targeted, and designed to be won in a three to five-year timeframe.

**FACT-BASED:** Our advocacy relies on scientific research to help us understand the ocean's problems and identify practical, effective solutions. We conduct research on a variety of issues that affect marine environments, from illegal and destructive fishing to plastic pollution and offshore drilling.

**EXPEDITION-POWERED:** We recognize that getting on the water – alongside scientists, divers, photographers, and campaigners – helps us bring these important marine places to life and make a stronger case for their protection. Oceana's expeditions have powered our campaigns and resulted in victories across the globe.

MULTI-DISCIPLINARY: Oceana's scientists work closely with our economists, lawyers, advocates, communicators, and grassroots organizers to achieve tangible results for the oceans.

**SUPPORTED BY CITIZENS AND ALLIES:** Oceana has a base of over 7.7 million supporters, including 1.2 million Wavemakers. Our Ocean Council comprises a select group of leaders in business, policy, and philanthropy who represent and support Oceana's efforts on the global stage.
